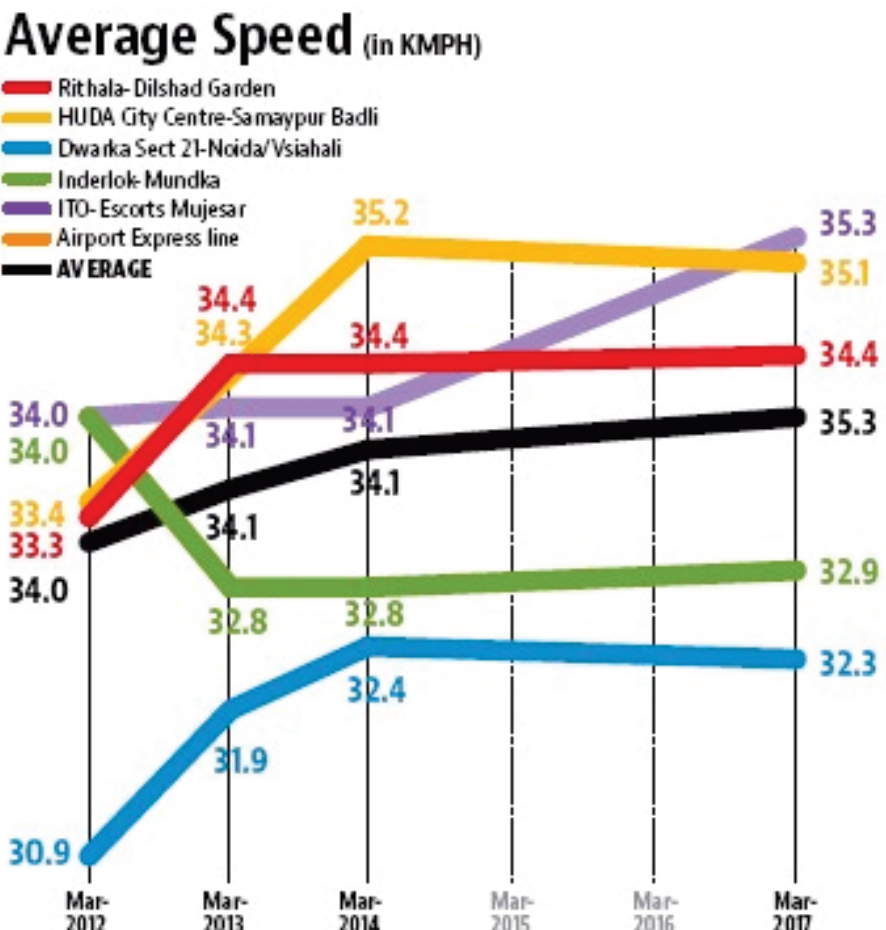
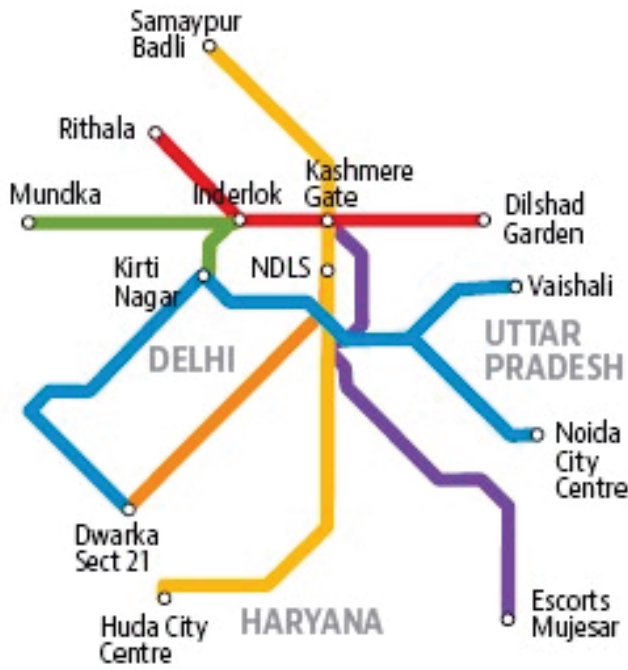

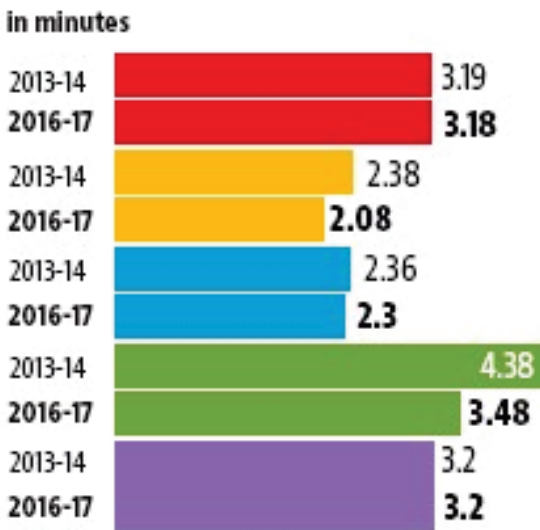

By innovative interventions, Delhi Metro has been able to increase frequency and average speed of trains. It has tackled the problem of crowding in trains and reduced journey time.



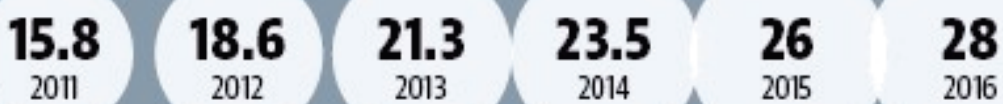
Frequency of trains

Audi driver who hit man returned to look for CCTV cameras

NEWDELHI: The south Delhi property dealer who had hit a 25-yearold juice seller in central Delhi on Saturday night returned to the scene of crime the following morning to check if there were any CCTV cameras, police said. Police arrested the driver Rajeev Malhotra on Monday evening after interrogating him for about 4-5 hours. Malhotra managed to get bail on Tuesday. He has been booked under section of causing death due to negligence and rash driving. On Saturday night, juice seller Manoj Yadav was impaled after he was allegedly hit by a speeding car in central Delhi's ITO. Manoj was flung in the air on impact and landed on the grills of a road divider which pierced his chest. A police officer said investigations revealed that the driver Rajeev Malhotra, a GK 1 resident, returned to work on Sunday morning in another

car. While driving to his office at Ansari road in Daryaganj, he reportedly stopped at the spot pretending to be a curious onlooker who wanted to see the 'bloody spot' where a man had died the night before, an officer said. Malhotra reportedly told police that a few hours before the accident he drank alcohol with his friend. He said he was returning home and driving at a high speed when he hit Manoj. But medical examination did not reveal the presence of liquor in his blood because Malhotra was arrested more than 36 hours after the accident. He had sped off from the spot, cleaned his car and dropped it at a friend's house in Noida. Police have recovered the Audi car. Malhotra was identified after the police team scanned CCTV footages from at least 20 different routes near the accident spot. Seven police teams were tracing the CCTV

cameras at different routes around Central Delhi. The victim Manoj Yadav was among the thousands of homeless men who live on the Delhi streets. He slept on the roof of a roadside juice shop in central Delhi, where he worked, more than 1,200 kilometres away from his family in Supaul, Bihar. On Saturday night, Manoj had left his shop outside the Doll museum in ITO, and was crossing the Bahadur Shah Zafar (BSZ) Marg in ITO to share dinner with homeless rickshawpullers who were sleeping on the central verge of the road, when a speeding white Audi car hit him. Manoj was flung at least 10-15 feet in the air and landed on an iron grill median — the rods impaling his chest and killing him on the spot. It took police and locals at least half an hour to remove his body from the grill.

Free access to women, kids in 270 north Delhi hotels, restaurants

NEW DELHI: Women and children in north Delhi can now access toilets at 270 hotels and restaurants, free of cost. The announcement comes almost three months after the South Delhi Municipal Corporation took a similar decision, prompting the east corporation to follow suit. Owners and associations of these hotels and restaurants have approved the north DMC's proposal. Preety Agarwal, mayor, North DMC, said the decision was taken for the convenience of women

and children, especially in areas where public toilets are not available. All the 270 hotel and restaurants are registered with the civic agency. Forty-seven restaurants/ hotels are in Karol Bagh zone, 12 in Narela, 72 in Rohini, 34 in the Sadar Paharganj and 14 in the city zone. This would be in addition to public washroom facilities made available by the corporation. Agarwal stickers are being pasted in front of the restaurants and hotels for information and awareness about the facility.

In May, the North Delhi Municipal Corporation commissioner PK Gupta had called a meeting with the hotel/restaurant associations to work out a road map to implement the decision. "The restaurants owners raised some safety issues but those have been sorted out," said the official. Apart from allowing free access, the North Delhi Municipal Corporation also requested the association members to adopt public toilets in and around their areas..

Cops gear up for makeover with utility belts, spl lathis

Soon, Delhi cops will get protective gear and equipment in line with their counterparts from the US and European countries. Police commissioner Amulya Patnaik has finalised a plan to procure a range of items like fibreglass helmets, polycarbonate shields and batons for his men. Apart from these, the city policemen will get utility belts, which will help them carry

a cop's full gear costs anything between \$5,000 and \$6,000 and weighs around 13kg. The full attire of a Delhi policeman will cost Rs 1-2 lakh, excluding the Glock pistol. In the West, a policeman usually wears a bulletproof vest and a duty belt. The latter is used to carry a Taser, a wireless set, two pairs of handcuffs, a flashlight, a baton, a Glock 22 pistol with ammunitions and an extra back-up weapon.

In Delhi, a cop carries nothing. At times, the holster is missing too as the pistol is tucked into their waist. Even the cops handling demonstrations and violent protests are seen wearing bike helmets. Those posted in police stations and the ones from specialised units like crime branch and special cell don't have protective gear either. These cops usually move around in civvies. "With just two pockets in trousers, which could barely accommodate an extra cellphone, the cops are forced to walk around with the bare minimum. They have to keep an extra mobile phone—used to speak to their sources and informers—inside their shirts, tightly tucked in," said an officer. The move to equip the cops with advanced gear comes in the wake of speculations that Delhi Police may soon be segregated into two wings: law and order and investigation. Each wing may be headed by a special commissioner with the commissioner being the overall head. The law and order may continue to have two divisions—north and south.

Biker shot at in road rage in Farsh Bazaar

NEW DELHI: A 22-year-old motorcyclist was shot by an unidentified Royal Enfield rider in east Delhi's Farsh Bazaar area on Monday night. The man was hit in his shoulder, but is out of danger, said police. The injured man, Rahbar Khan, lives in Khureji with his parents who run a local business. It was around midnight that Khan was returning to his home after attending a birthday party when the attack happened. As Khan was returning home, he decided to get his bike refueled. It was at this moment that he entered into an argument with an Enfield

rider, following which the man allegedly pulled out a pistol and shot at him before riding away. Khan was rushed to a hospital and is out of danger, police said. Based on his statement, a case of attempt to murder was registered at Farsh Bazaar police station. A senior police officer quoted Rahbar as claiming that the attack was a result of a quarrel over road space after the two vehicles brushed past each other. However, there have been inconsistencies in his statement, said the officer, adding that is being questioned.

Ggn war memorial vandalised a day before Kargil Vijay Divas

GURGAON: Broken benches, damaged floodlights and scratched plaques — this was the sight of Rezang La war memorial in Palam Vihar on Tuesday morning when members of the Martyr's family welfare foundation visited the site to plan celebrations ahead of the Kargil Vijay Divas on Wednesday. "We were shocked to look at the site. All the eight benches, which are made of stones, had been broken and the floodlights were smashed," TC Rao, convener of the Rezangla Sahidi Samaroh. Rao called it 'an insult to the war veterans'. He said the 7,000 sq feet memorial was inaugurated by the then Haryana chief minister Bhopinder Singh Hooda on

December 29, 2012. It was constructed to honour 114 martyrs who sacrificed their lives during the historic battle of Rezang La in 1962 with China. A majority of war heroes of the 13th Kumaon Regiment were from south Haryana districts of Gurgaon, Rewari and Mahendragarh. "This sad state of affairs show how much we respect their sacrifices," he added. By Tuesday evening, an FIR was registered against unknown persons under section 427 (mischief causing damage to property) and prevention of damage to Public property Act. Palam Vihar SHO Praveen Malik said they received the complaint late in the evening. He said that no CCTV cameras were

available which could capture the act and that investigation is on. "We visited the spot and found out that the memorial had indeed been damaged," he said. A group of association members met at the memorial on Tuesday to decide about the Kargil Divas celebrations. "But our celebrations turned into sorrow. This was not one person's or one association's property, it is the country's heritage," said Col (ret'd) Mahavir Yadav, a member of the association.
